# FAITHFUL WHEN IT'S HARD

# 1. Introduction: What Does It Mean to Be Faithful? (10 minutes)

Activity: "Staying True"


- · Begin by asking: What does it mean to be faithful?
- · Let the children give examples keeping promises, helping a friend, obeying parents, or standing by someone when others do not.
- · Explain: To be faithful means to stay true to someone or something even when it is hard.


## Discussion:

Explain that some Christians around the world face difficulties because they love Jesus. They are still faithful to Him, even when it costs them a lot.


# 2. Story Time (15 minutes)


Story: "Rahul's Choice in India"





Rahul felt sad and afraid. He didn't want to lose his friends, but he also didn't want to stop following Jesus. That evening, Rahul prayed, "Dear Jesus, please help me be brave. I want to stay faithful to You."





# Learning:

Jesus loves us and helps us to be faithful. Even when it is hard, we can pray for courage and know that God is with us.

### Discussion:

- How did Rahul show faithfulness?
- · What helped him stay strong?
- · How can we stay faithful to Jesus when others tease or exclude us?

# 3. Craft Activity: "Faith Promise Bracelet" (20 minutes)

· Materials: string, paper or cardboard strips, markers, glue/tape.

### Instructions:

- · Give each child a strip or small pieces of paper to thread or join.
- · On each piece, children can write or draw: faith, courage, prayer, love, hope.
- · Link or tape the pieces into a small bracelet or chain.
- · Explain: Each word reminds us of what helps us to be faithful to Jesus.

# Prayer Points:

- · Pray that Christians who face persecution will have courage.
- · Pray that children like Rahul will stay faithful.
- · Pray that we will trust Jesus when things are difficult.
- · Pray for people who hurt Christians that they will know God's love.

# 4. Bible Verse & Memory Time (10 minutes)

Verse: "Nothing can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." — Romans 8:39

# Activity:

- · Say the verse together several times.
- · Let children repeat the words "Nothing can separate us!" loudly and joyfully.
- · Explain: Even when life is hard, God's love stays with us.

# 5. Closing Prayer (5 minutes)

Invite the children to hold hands or bow their heads and pray together:

"Lord Jesus, thank You for loving us. Help us to stay faithful to You, even when it is hard. Please protect and comfort children and families who face persecution. Amen."

# SESSION TWO

# FAITHFUL TO THE END

# 1. Opening Activity: "Stand Firm!" (10 minutes)

Play a game similar to "Simon Says."


- · When you say, "Stand firm for Jesus!" the children stand strong like a superhero.
- When you give any other instruction without "Stand firm for Jesus," they should stay still.
- · Continue for several rounds and have fun!


# Discussion:


Talk about how sometimes it is hard to stand firm for Jesus when others do not believe or when life is difficult — but God gives us strength.

# 2. Story Time (15 minutes)

Read or tell the story from Acts 6-7 (in simple words):







# Discussion:

- · What made Stephen faithful?
- · How did he respond to people who hurt him?
- · What does this story teach us about loving and trusting Jesus?

# 3. Craft Activity: "Faith Heroes" (20 minutes)

Give each child a printed sheet (see below Annex 1) with:

- · A picture of Stephen praying.
- · A space to draw or write about someone who is faithful to Jesus today (a missionary, pastor, or even themselves).
- · A short prayer line: "Dear Jesus, help me be faithful like \_\_\_\_."
- · Let them share their drawings and prayers.

# 4. Group Activity: "Building a Wall of Faith" (15 minutes)

Materials: paper "bricks" or rectangles.

## Instructions:

- Each child writes or draws one thing that helps them stay faithful (e.g., prayer, Bible, family, church).
- · Tape the bricks onto a wall or board to make a "Wall of Faith."
- · Explain: Together, we are strong when we support and pray for each other.

# 5. Memory Verse & Closing Prayer (10 minutes)

### Verse:

"Be faithful, even to the point of death, and I will give you life as your victor's crown." — Revelation 2:10


Practice repeating the verse together slowly.
